## Girls Uniform Policy PK3-5th Grade

- ★Uniforms are required to project an atmosphere of uniformity, pride, loyalty and equality among the student population. Uniforms remove some of the distractions, make students feel included and tend to make students feel like part of a “team” at school.
- ★Parents are required to support the policy and insure only the approved uniform is worn
- ★The exclusive formal uniform supplier for SJES is **Lands’ End**, and all items listed on the St James School page are approved uniform items.
- ★Lands’ End uniform shop can be accessed online through the school website, or by visiting [www.landsend.com](http://www.landsend.com) and searching for preferred school number **900150483**.
- ★Jeans may have holes, but must remain modest where skin is visible. No holes higher than mid thigh.
- ★NO temporary tattoos or other body art
- ★NO jewelry except for a small watch and/or a small, modest, religious necklace may be worn. Necklace must stay tucked into polo shirts for safety reasons on the playground.
- ★**Please label all outerwear with students’ name.**

### WEATHER POLICY

- Winter wear is for outdoor activities
- Rain boots may be worn on rainy days, but students must change into uniform shoes upon entering the building
- **Students will remain inside if the weather is below 40° as indicated by the school’s weather system**

### IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Formal Wednesday uniforms must be worn every Wednesday unless notified by your child’s teacher or the school office
- Uniform polo and navy or black bike shorts must be worn under jumpers on formal Wednesdays
- Tees must be tucked into skirts, skorts or pants at all times
- Skirts, skorts and jumpers are to be no shorter than 3 inches above the knee
- Long sleeve white shirt may be worn under uniform tee
- Tennis shoes may not have flashing lights or wheels,
- Rain boots may be worn to school when it is raining, but students must change into their tennis shoes upon entering the building
- Hair must be neat, clean, well-groomed and not cover the face.

### MONDAY DRESS CODE

1. School spirit shirt
2. Blue, black, or white jeans, shorts or skirt, or uniform bottoms
3. Solid white socks
4. Tennis shoes of your choosing- **Required, NO flashing lights, NO wheels**
5. Navy, white, gray or Lands’ End Plaid hair accessories-optional

### TUESDAY, THURSDAY & FRIDAY DRESS CODE

1. Uniform polo in white, light blue or navy- **Logo Required**
2. Lands’ End plaid skirt, skort, or jumper
3. Solid white socks
4. Tennis shoes of your choosing- **Required, NO flashing lights, NO wheels**
5. Navy or white knee socks or tights- optional
6. Navy uniform pants during winter months-optional
7. Navy, white, gray or Lands’ End Plaid hair accessories-optional
8. Solid navy, gray or black cardigan, zip up hoodie, or light weight jacket- optional

### FORMAL WEDNESDAY DRESS CODE

1. Uniform Polo in white- **Logo Required**
2. Plaid Jumper- **Required**
3. Tennis shoes of your choosing- **Required, NO flashing lights, NO wheels**
4. Solid white socks
5. Navy, white, gray or Lands’ End Plaid hair accessories
6. Solid navy, gray or black cardigan, zip up hoodie, or light weight jacket- optional

### NO UNIFORM DAYS

Students may bring \$1 to come out of uniform on Dollar Dress Down Days. Clothing must still follow policy. No offensive/scary tee shirts or costume-like attire, tennis shoes must be worn to ensure safety on the playground and during PE; NO flashing lights or heelys. All rules listed in “Important Information” apply on No Uniform Days as well.

### RAM SPIRIT DAYS

1. Ram spirit shirt
2. Blue, black, or white jeans, shorts or skirt, or uniform bottoms
3. Solid white socks
4. Tennis shoes of your choosing- **Required, NO flashing lights, NO wheels**
